At Park Home Ranch, we are here for all of your moments! Our 120-year-old barn is on a working ranch in the Carson Valley with sweeping views of the Sierra Nevada Mountain Range. Having worked on this land for generations, the Park family has been responsible for the stewardship and conservation of the agricultural heritage of Douglas County.

We are centrally located 15 minutes south of Nevada's state capital and bordering Lake Tahoe. Our beautiful valley lies on Nevada's western border, framed by the Carson Range and the Pine Nut Mountains. In the 750 square miles it encompasses, you will find open spaces, expansive ranches and farms, historical sites, and a wealth of year-round recreational activities. The elevation ranges from a low on the valley floor of 4,625 to a high of 9,500 feet at East Peak.



Park Home Ranch offers multiple options for weddings, receptions, birthdays, bridal and baby showers, family reunions, celebrations of life, corporate events, and more.

Things to Share with your Guests

PARKING

Parking is on the east side of the barn. Turn onto Home Ranch Road and follow until you reach the bridge in front of the pump house. Make a right, go over the bridge; the lot will be the open space to the left; please only park past the walkway over the creek. There are two handicap-accessible parking spots next to the barn on the other side of the handicap-accessible restroom.

OPEN AREAS

We welcome your guest to enjoy the venue, but please, stay away from the cattle, ranch stalls, and the creek. The bridal and groomsman suites are for before the ceremony and are not an open area during the wedding or reception for guests.

1918 BRICK BUILDING

No one is to be in or around the building, the vacant building, or the pile of bricks.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted on site. There is a designated area on the side of the brick building; please use the pot for butts. Any butts found after the event will result in a \$500.00 fine to the renter.

OPEN FLAMES

There are not to be flames of any type at the venue, including but not limited to: candles, charcoal grills, fire pits, and sparklers.

GRASS AREAS

Ceremony chairs and yard games are allowed on the grass but must not be left overnight. No tables or wine barrels are allowed.

YESES AND NO'S

Yes, to birdseed, flower petals, and bubbles outside the barn. No rice, confetti, or fake flower petals anywhere.
