





WEDDING CHECKLIST

Please provide us with the following information and documentation as your booked date approaches.

DAY OF CONTRACT SIGNING PAY FIRELIGHT FARM VENUE FEE DEPOSIT Note: 10 days after signing the contract, this venue fee deposit becomes non-refundable.
AT LEAST 120 DAYS BEFORE EVENT IF APPLICABLE, DEADLINE TO SUBMIT CANCELLATION IN WRITING TO FIRELIGHT FARM Notice of cancellation will relieve client of paying remaining amount of venue fee and security deposit, although initial payment is non-refundable.
AT LEAST 60 DAYS BEFORE EVENT COORDINATE WALK-THROUGHS OF VENUE Each walk-through must be scheduled at least 15 days prior to the event. Please plan accordingly to incorporate this in your timeline.
PROVIDE FIRELIGHT FARM WITH THE NAME, EMAIL ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER OF YOUR PROFESSIONAL PLANNER/COORDINATOR
PROVIDE FIRELIGHT FARM WITH PROOF OF REQUIRED EVENT INSURANCE
PROVIDE FIRELIGHT FARM WITH PROOF OF REQUIRED INSURANCE FOR CATERER AND BARTENDING SERVICE
PROVIDE FIRELIGHT FARM WITH BARTENDING SERVICE'S PERMIT TO SERVE ALCOHOL

WEDDING CHECKLIST

AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE EVENT PAY \$1,000 SECURITY DEPOSIT AND REMAINING BALANCE TO FIRELIGHT FARM
COORDINATE TIME OF CEREMONY REHEARSAL (IF AVAILABLE) WITH FIRELIGHT FARM
PROVIDE FIRELIGHT FARM WITH THE FINAL CEREMONY SET UP, RECEPTION LAYOUT AND SCHEDULE OF EVENTS We are happy to work with your planner on a floor plan that fits your needs.
SUBMIT COMPLETE LIST OF ALL VENDORS, INCLUDING CONTACT INFORMATION TO FIRELIGHT FARM FOR FINAL APPROVAL
IF APPLICABLE, NOTIFY FIRELIGHT FARM OF TENT RENTAL PROVIDER AND PLACEMENT OF TENTS
PROVIDE PREFERRED TIMES FOR USE OF FIRE PIT IN WRITING TO FIRELIGHT FARM
DAY BEFORE EVENT REHEARSE CEREMONY/EVENT AT DESIGNATED TIME Rehearsal may occur on the day prior to the event within venue's discretion

REMINDER

All caterers must provide full service throughout the event and follow the caterer's use policy form. An insured caterer and bartender are required. Your caterer and bartender must provide proof of liability insurance with coverage of at least 1 million per occurrence at least 30 days prior to your wedding. If this is not provided the vendor will not be allowed on site. Please refer to our legal contract.





WEDDING CHECKLIST

DAY OF EVENT SET UP OF EVENT MAY BEGIN AT 11 AM
FINISH EVENT BY 12 AM AT THE LATEST
DECORATIONS MUST BE REMOVED AND STORED IN DESIGNATED AREA AFTER EVENT BY 1 AM AT THE LATEST
DAY AFTER EVENT RENTALS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY MUST BE PICKED UP BY 9 AM Includes stored decorations, vehicles etc.
PAY ADDITIONAL COST IF DAMAGE EXCEEDS AMOUNT OF SECURITY DEPOSIT - 30 DAYS AFTER EVENT AT THE







VENUE MANAGER RESPONSIBILITIES

What's the Difference Between Venue Manager & an Event Planner?

A Firelight venue manager is present for all events. Firelight does not employ on-site general laborers, event coordinators or event planners. Firelight Farm requires that a professional wedding planner or day-of coordinator is hired to manage the on-site coordination of vendors and the ceremony.

VENUE MANAGER (DAY OF)

UNLOCKS AND LOCKS THE DOORS OF THE VENUE
ADDRESSES QUESTIONS AND CONCERNS RELATED TO THE VENUE
KEEPS BATHROOM CLEAN AND TRASH REMOVED FROM RECEPTACLES
MONITORS SOUND
ENSURES ALL VENUE RULES ARE FOLLOWED

CLEANS UP FOLLOWING THE EVENT

NOTE:

The venue fee includes at least one on-site staff member to be present an hour prior to the ceremony time. Firelight staff will be available to answer questions and concerns dealing with the property and to ensure rules and regulations are upheld. Firelight staff will also periodically check the restrooms for cleanliness throughout the evening. During the time prior to the ceremony, our venue manager will be available by phone.

EVENT PLANNER RESPONSIBILITIES

CLEANS UP REAL FLOWER PETALS FROM CEREMONY AREA AND ANY EXCESS TRASH GENERATED BY GUEST

THE COORDINATOR THEMSELF OR APPOINTED BAR OR CATERING STAFF IS RESPONSIBLE TO ENSURE ALL GLASSWARE & FLATWARE IS SORTED AND PLACED INTO DESIGNATED LOCATION DURING THE EVENT

LOADS ALL GIFTS AND PERSONAL ITEMS INTO DESIGNATED VEHICLE

ENSURES THE VENUE IS BEING RESPECTED BY ALL PARTIES

FOLLOWS UP AFTER THE EVENT TO ENSURE CLIENTS ARE HAPPY AND ALL ITEMS WERE RETURNED



The following scenarios are developed with your comfort in mind and based on our extensive knowledge of the barn and surrounding grounds.



THE FOUR SEASONS

SUMMER LATE JUNE - EARLY SEPTEMBER

Recommended capacity 130

Summer is our busiest season at Firelight Farm so dates fill up fast! When booking your summer wedding we recommend reserving your date as soon as possible. Please bare in mind that outdoor ceremonies and receptions are weather dependant and it's always a good idea to have a plan B. It is normal to experience fleeting rain shower in Montana throughout the summer and although June is a summer month the weather is especially unpredictable at this time, therefor outdoor access during June is weather dependant.

AUTUMN

LATE SEPTEMBER- EARLY NOVEMBER

Recommended capacity 130

Fall is beautiful and fleeting on the farm as the cottonwood and aspen trees turn brilliant shades of ochre and gold. During these months our clients are especially grateful for our firepit and love to set out baskets of blankets for guests to cozy up with. Be aware that as the holidays approach availability becomes scarce. At this time access to our outdoor spaces is weather dependant.

WINTER

DECEMBER - FEBRUARY

Recommended capacity 100

Winter in Montana is truly something to behold. With everything blanketed in fluffy white snow you and your guests may enjoy world class skiing at one of two neighboring ski hills in the days leading up to, or following, your wedding. Our barn is the absolute definition of cozy when the sun sets early and the edison bulbs are lit. With temperature regulated heat, luxury bathrooms and our catering kitchen, you and your guests needn't leave once the party guest's started, unless of course you want to venture outside and gather around our beautiful fire pit.

SPRING LATE MAY - EARLY JUNE

Recommended capacity 100

During the spring Firelight Farm takes a well deserved break. With unpredictable weather conditions and the spring thaw we are unable to guarantee available dates during this time, though we do occasionally make an exception for smaller weddings.

*While there is snow on the ground, and during "mud season" we do require a shuttle for guests. At this time access to our outdoor spaces is limited, and weather dependant.
