Lovingston Winery, located in the rolling countryside of the Blue Ridge Mountains, specializes in producing exclusively estate grown wines.

Josie's Knoll Vineyard consists of 11.5 acres of densely-planted vines — ranging from the Bordeaux varietals of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot to the South African Pinotage as well as Seyval Blanc, Chardonnay, and Petit Manseng. This “dense-planting” — 1,200 vines to the acre — stems from the idea that by limiting the number of grape bunches a vine is able to produce, that vine concentrates all of its energy into those fewer clusters, increasing the quality of the fruit.

The winery, built into a hillside on our family farm, employs a gravity-flow production method, allowing us to virtually eliminate the use of pumps and other mechanization. In addition, we ferment the grapes in small batches to allow for a more hands-on approach to wine making and increased quality control.

Lovington Winery is completely surrounded by rolling pasture, vineyard, mountain, mature oak and pond scenes, delighting all those who visit. Despite easy highway access, you feel as though you have been transported miles into peaceful wine country.



Years of History :
Over its 115 years, this property has only known three different families as owners. The old wine bottles in the woods, creaks in the farmhouse floors and etchings into trees all come together to show this is a place that has been lived in and loved on for decades.



THE FARMHOUSE

The Farmhouse at Lovington Winery serves as the heart of the property. Seated on top of a hill, it is surrounded by vineyard, pond and forest views. The lawn is filled with massive 250 year old oak trees that offer both shade and beauty. Nestled on the east side of the home is a flat, grassy space perfect for ceremonies.

Inside the home there are four bedrooms, three full bathrooms, a kitchen with Viking appliances, a living room, parlor, and dining room. The primary suite is located on the main floor and has nearly 360' views of vineyards. On top of the great views, the primary suite has a bathroom with heated floors, a six jet walk-in shower, bay windows, a king-sized bed, and a floor to ceiling mirror great for getting ready.

Upstairs, the charm of the historic farmhouse structure is evident throughout with original floors and layout. The three large rooms can accommodate up to eight guests with a king, queen and two full beds.

This home place, originally referred to as "The Hill" was built by John Stevens. Josie, his wife, served as the matriarch of the family and property until 1969 and is still fondly remembered by local family members.

The tobacco fields that originally surrounded the home are now replaced by vineyards lovingly referred to as "Josie's Knoll".



THE CABIN

The Cabin at Lovington Winery sits tucked above the vineyards with some of the best mountain views on the property. With all the cozy feels of a log cabin, you'll also find beautiful modern touches throughout. Our kitchen is freshly renovated with everything needed to host a backyard rehearsal dinner. The surrounding lawn contains a charcoal grill and fire pit that are great for gatherings.

Inside, there are three bedrooms that can sleep up to six guests. The primary suite has a king sized bed and private bathroom. The other two rooms contain a queen bed and two twin beds. You'll find an open concept living room, dining room, and kitchen with a large back porch just outside for easy al fresco meals.

This space serves as a versatile, completely private area, with easy accessibility to the Farmhouse, can go in any direction you need!



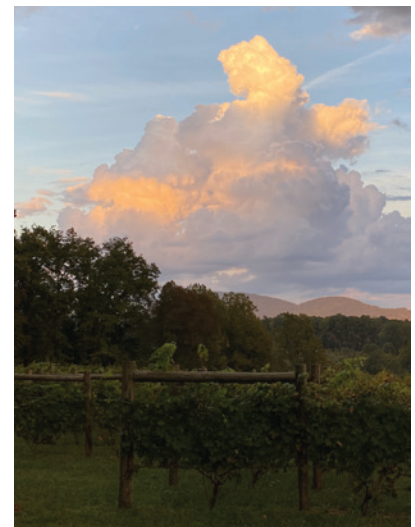

Also included in your package are two nights of lodging at Lovingston Winery in the farmhouse and cabin. This allows for space to get ready for your big day, and a place for guests to stay. With the capability of sleeping up to sixteen, there is ample room!

Wine

Lastly, Lovingston Winery provides our award-winning wine for your event. The couple receives two free tastings to select the wines to serve at their wedding and 10% off any wine purchased for wedding day serving. We are happy to offer advice from our knowledgeable staff to select the best pairings for your day.
