The Venue At River's Edge, formerly the Waterloo Community Hall, is a brick Neoclassical building in the Waterloo Downtown Historic District. It was built in 1926 as a community hall, funded by the local community, to serve its many needs. With its large, lighted stage and expansive wood-floored auditorium, it has served countless community events.

Lacking attic insulation, heat, and care, the community hall fell into disuse and disrepair for many years until Lee Columbus, the current owner, purchased it in February of 2017 and began the extensive renovations that have resulted in this beautiful venue.
