1898

320 Guest Ranch traces its roots back to 1898, when Sam Wilson purchased 160 acres to homestead on in the Gallatin Valley. Two years later, his father purchased the adjoining 160 acres thus creating "Buffalo Horn Resort" nestled on, you guessed it...320 acres.


In 1911, Caroline McGill moved to Montana and was the first woman pathologist in the state. McGill had her reservations about moving to Montana and in a letter to her family said, "I'll tell you right now I am making the biggest fool mistake to go . . . but I'm going...Feels sort of funny to stand off and serenely watch myself commit suicide, [but] I'll just have to let her rip." McGill's intuition to move to Montana paid off as her legacy will live on as one of the most compassionate doctors to ever live.

In 1936, McGill purchased the 320 Ranch as a retreat for her patients, family, & friends. She believed people could benefit from nature & encouraged everyone to "get out, walk, ride, or sit in the Mountains in order to cure more ills than medicine or medical knowledge in existence." While McGill will live on as one of the greatest doctors in the area, 320 Ranch will remember her for her spirit & soul which lingers within the true essence of the 320 Ranch.

When McGill passed in 1959, she gave the Goodrich's, her closest friends and employees on the ranch the opportunity to purchase it. They did & carried on in her legacy.

Pictured above are Jim & Pat Goodrich riding away on their wedding wagon at the 320 Ranch in 1953. A few generations later, the Goodrich's sold the ranch to the current owner, Dave Brask, in 1987.




